This Month's Tip

Dixie Style to an Ocean Wave

(This call ends in a **LEFT** hand ocean wave
w/Men in Center)

From facing lines and assuming the girls are on the right side of the boy.....

1. Ladies, give a RIGHT hand to the lady you're facing and pull by while Men sidestep into partner's vacated spot (having the men sidestep into ladies vacated spot will line the men up much better to be able to give the oncoming girl their LEFT hand/forearm).

2. Men & Ladies join LEFT hands/forearms and turn $\frac{1}{4}$ - keep left hand/forearm hold

3. Men, you're in the Center of the Wave, join RIGHT hands/forearms to complete formation of the wave.
